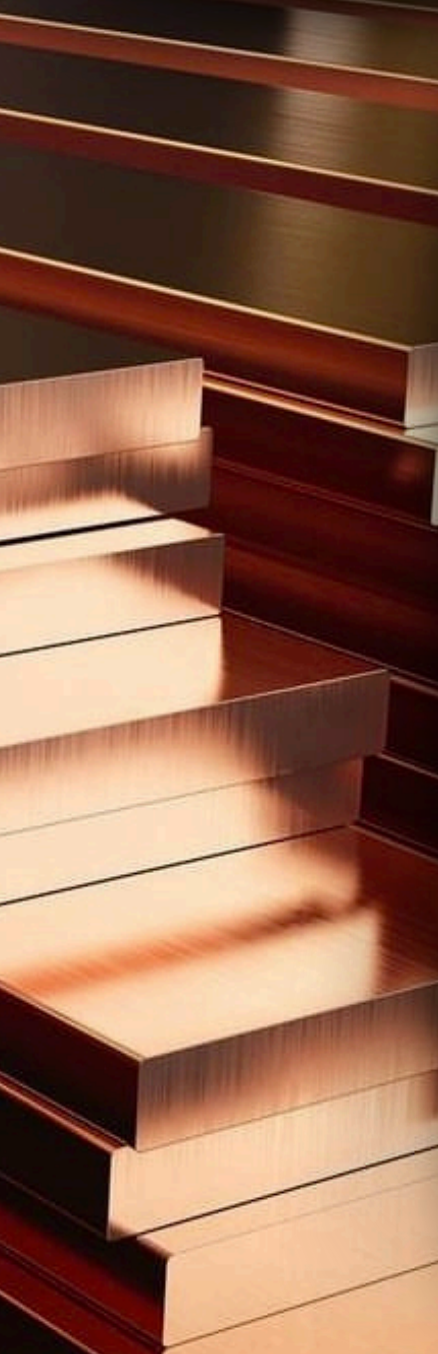
OUR PURPOSE

DECARBONISATION

We have already managed to decrease our Gas Usage by an impressive 84%, whilst demonstrating a 5%, on average, year on year decrease in our carbon footprint since 2016 and we intend to mitigate this more through the following plans in the coming years.

At ILF Ltd, we not only pride ourselves with the reductions already achieved whilst already using some usable sources of power such as Wind and Solar, we have plans to also extend this further with installing Solar Panels within our operation, to help reduce further our carbon footprint but also help reduce the national infrastructure through localising our power source and strengthening the business through battery storage.

For example, based on the following assumptions:

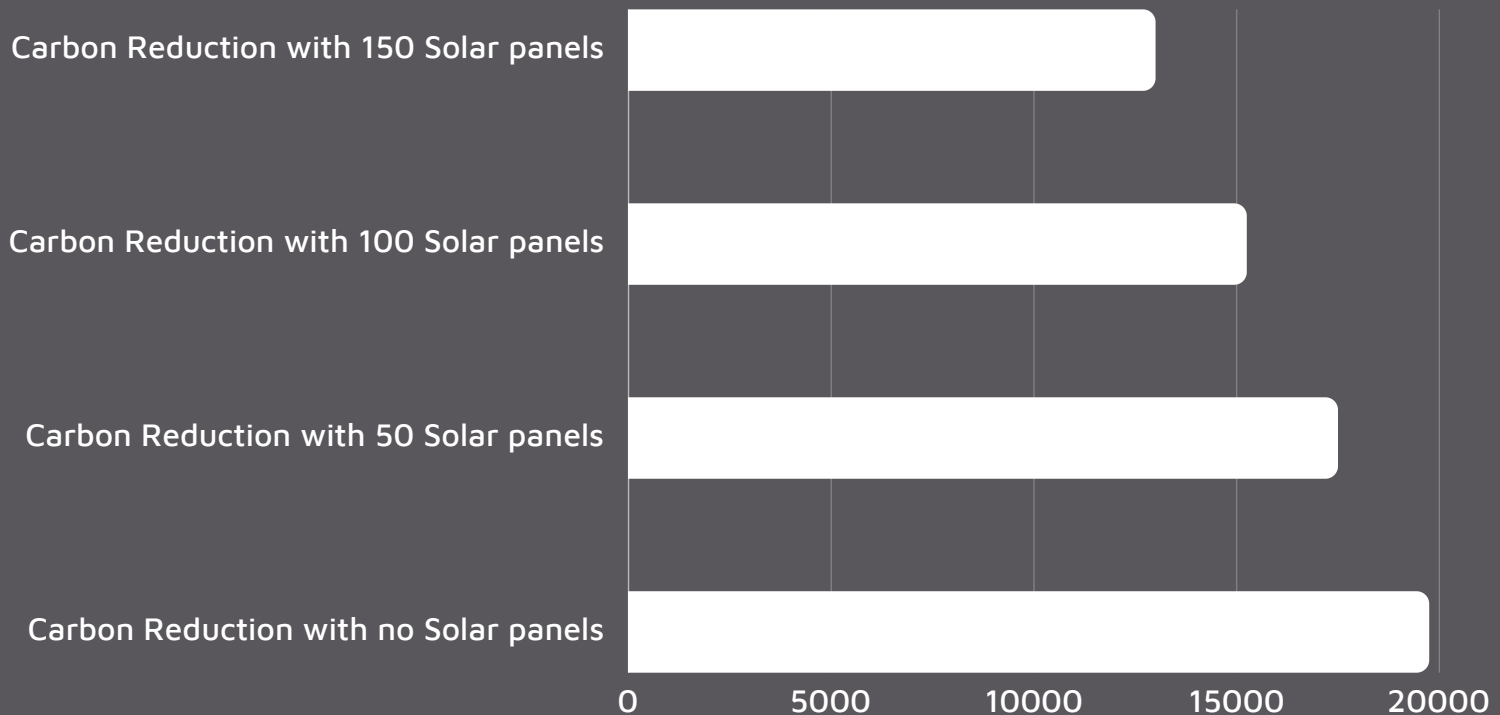
Each square meter of solar panel would produce approximately 0.432 kWh per day, or 157.68 kWh annually, under average UK solar irradiance conditions, with an 18% efficient panel and an 80% performance ratio.

To generate 4,165 kWh per year, you would need approximately 26.41 square meters of solar panels.

Given typical solar panels are about 1.6 square meters in size (for example, a standard 300W panel), you would need approximately 17 panels (rounding up from 16.51 to account for whole panels).

Therefore, to generate 4,165 kWh of power per month under these conditions, you would need about 205 solar panels.

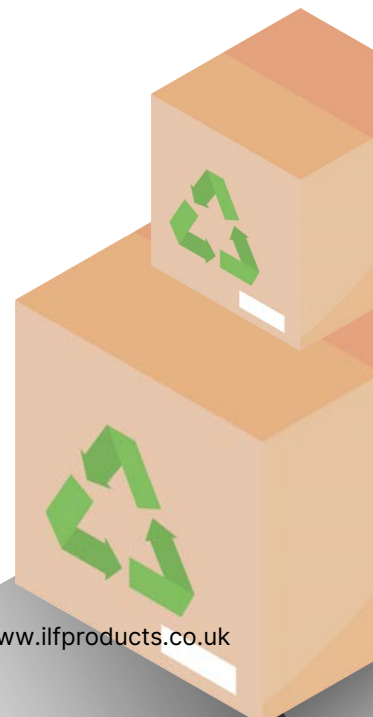

Reusable Packaging

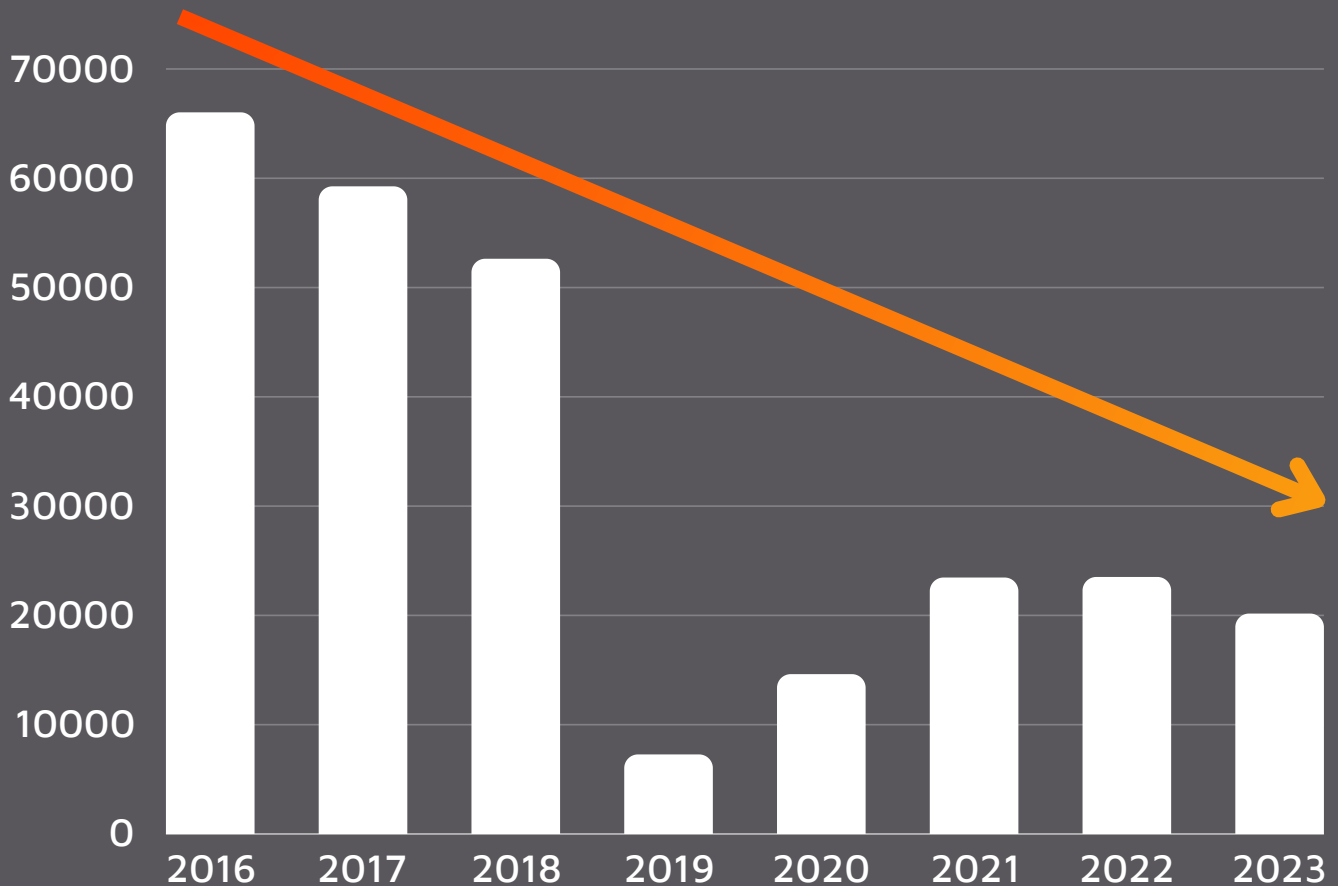

Carbon reduction between 2016 - 2023



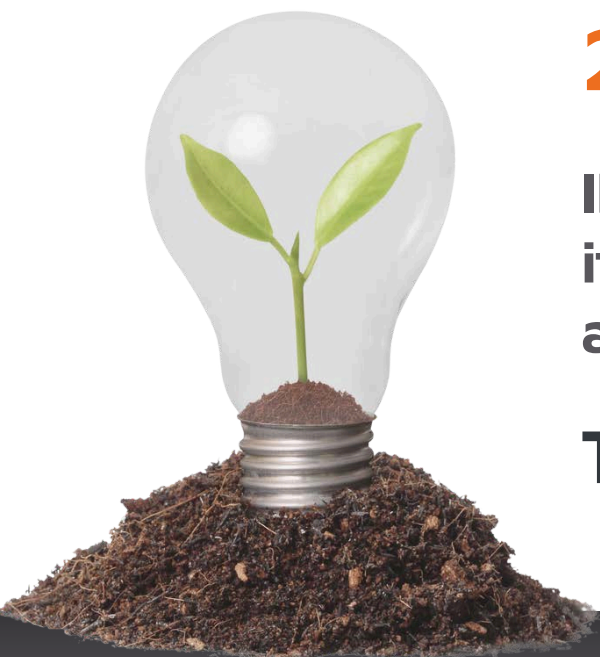

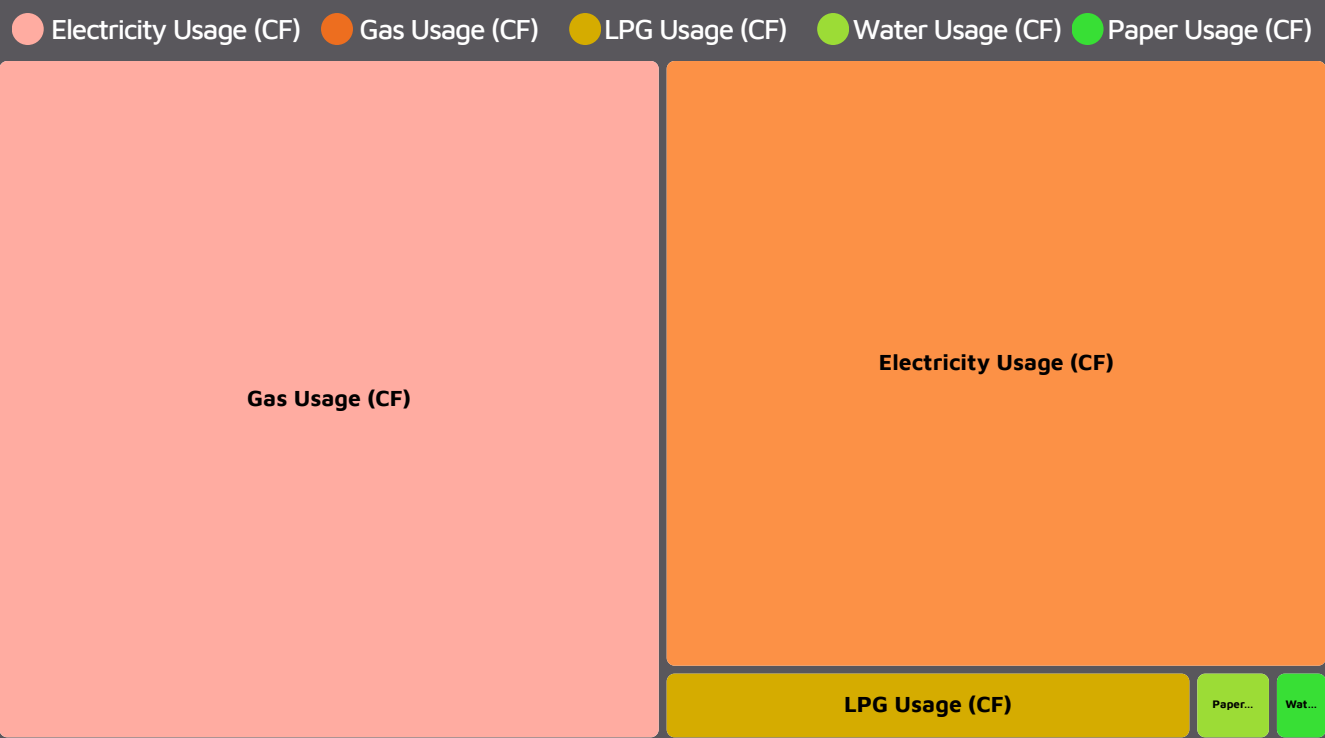

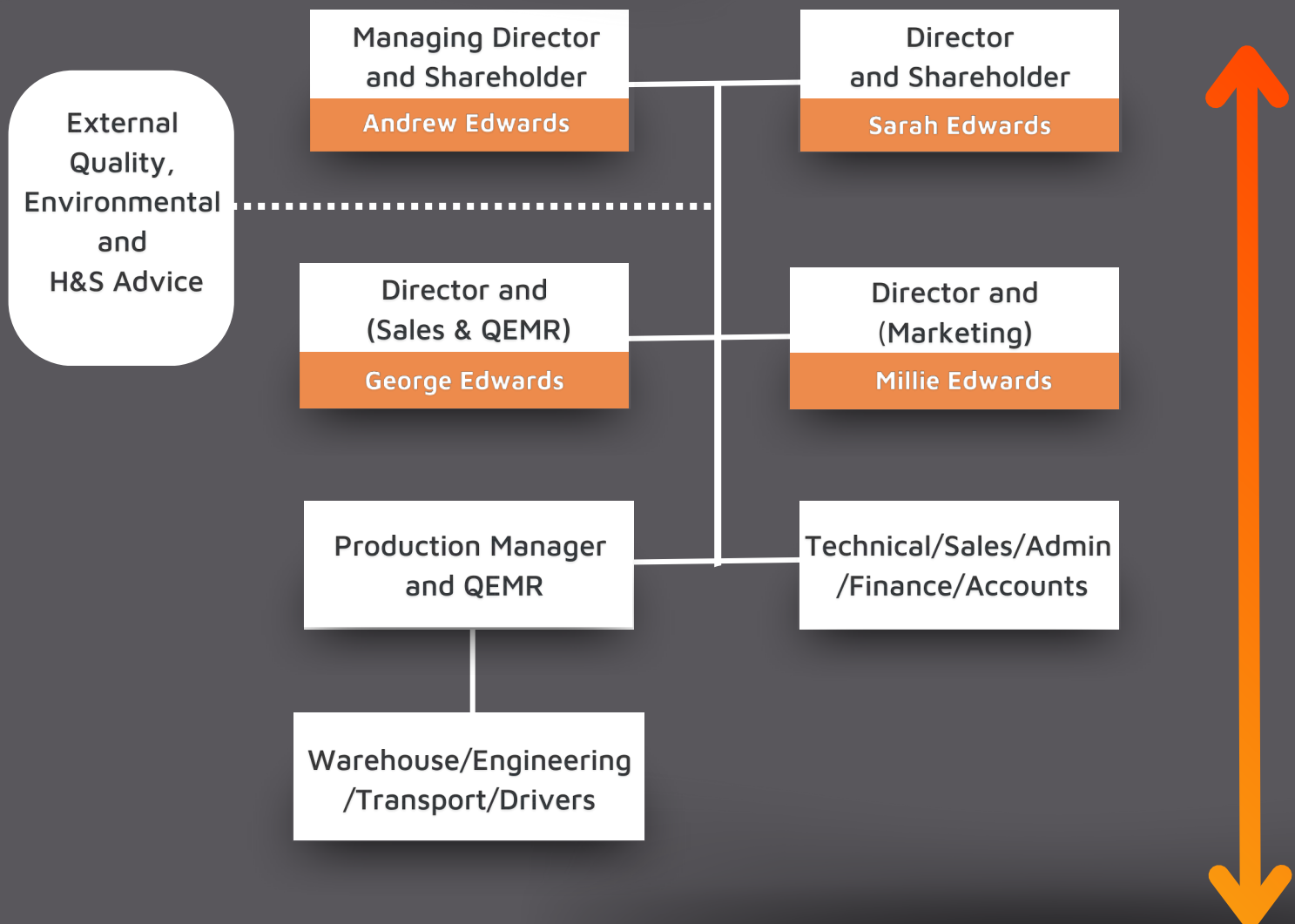
